

I, too, have been caught in the lies of Lacy Elizabeth Johnson. Was a very close friend of her mother Ann and have known Lacy since birth. While her mother was alive, I had consistent contact with the family, spending many happy hours. Having no children of my own, I considered Morgan and Lacy to be my "god children", loving them very much. After Ann's death in November 2004, contact was less often, then none at all.

September 2009 received a call from Lacy with the brain cancer story. After hearing the story, I was devastated. She needed money for experimental oxygen therapy in Tijuana. I loaned her \$35,500. The story is consistent with what has been posted - selling TV shows, waiting to be paid, will repay me once she gets the funds! I even spoke with her Dad, (Jon) Matthew Johnson to verify her illness, which he confirmed.

The last correspondence to Lacy was March 2010 when I sent letter asking for at least \$10,000 payment. When I tried calling her, the cell number was invalid. I have had no further contact.

It is with a heavy heart that I am conveying this very personal information. I feel ashamed that I was taken for so much money, and it has been difficult financially for me since I am retired and on fixed income. I love Lacy like a daughter and would have done anything for her. Out of love, money was given with a promise of return. I'm very hurt.
