

Lacy Elizabeth Johnson worked for me as an assistant and helping with selling items of mine on eBay from April 12th of 2010 until September 7th of 2010 when she burglarized my home.

Lacy is a very clever and very convincing girl. I had no suspicion that she had broken into my home until Detective [REDACTED], who was investigating the burglary, said it had to be an inside job. After that Lacy was acting strange and I found stolen goods of mine in a storage unit owned by her. When Detective [REDACTED] went to arrest her she found stolen property of mine at her home.

It was after this discovery that I found out almost everything Lacy had told me about her life was a lie. When Lacy first started working for me she told me her mother and father were both dead. Her father was alive and well at the time. Less than two weeks after Lacy started working for me she told me her brother had committed suicide by shooting himself and she had to have a hazmat team come in and clean up. I was so distraught for her I started to cry. She then asked if I could help with the costs since he had left no money and she wanted to give him a proper funeral. Since I had only known her less than 2 weeks I said I could not. It turns out that was a lie and her brother is alive and well and thought to be her accomplice.

I also found out at the time she was working for me and telling me she was planning her wedding she in fact had two fiancé's and 2 boyfriends. All of whom she was scamming for money. I was able to meet the fiancé she was living with at the time and he too was discovering that most everything Lacy had told him was a lie. He and his parents combined lost \$30,000 to Lacy's cancer scam.

Also during the time Lacy worked for me she told me she had stage 4 breast cancer and hoped I could help her pay for alternative treatments. At this point I was starting to think she was either incredibly unlucky or a liar so I told her I would think about it. This was just one week before she burglarized my home.

I have since then spoken with multiple victims of Lacy's cancer scams and was shocked at how many people she was able to get money from. It is over \$200,000 that we know of to date.
